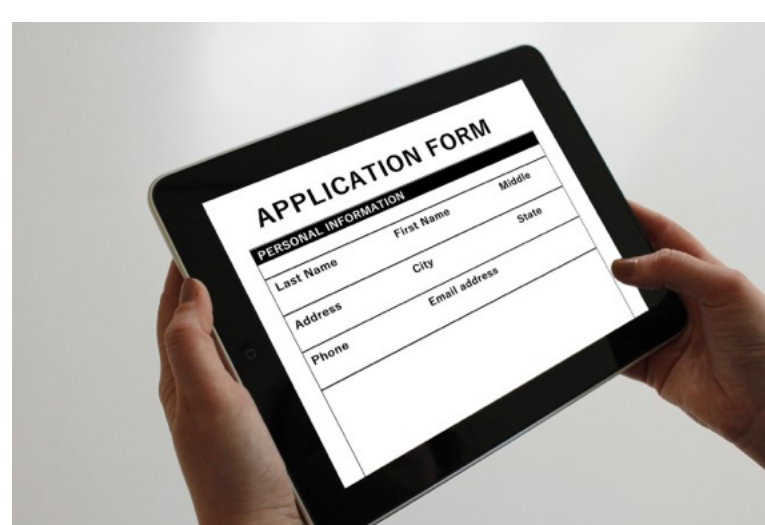
Don't miss out on grant funding
