

 - Feedback indicates interest to remain local if they could find suitable graduate work



6 Weeks Internship




 Worked as a Product Development Chemist – to understand the random quality issues the products of Reactive Components were developing





My day-to-day tasks

- Write work instructions for a variety of analytical instruments.
- Plan and conduct a series of experiment.
- Run the samples obtained from the experiments under the DSC and analyse the data produced.
- Collect the analysis, organise the data in tables and graph to write a scientific report.
